SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

From March 24th to September 26th, 2003, Sergeant [redacted] was assigned to the Quartermaster Stores Unit and Central Property Bureau as an administrative Supervisor. During the six month period, Sergeant [redacted] harassed members of the Quartermaster Stores Bureau contrary to the Peel Regional Police Directive 1-A-205(F). The harassment included inappropriate comments, unwanted touching and rubbing and e-mail messages that consisted of racial slurs, derogatory and sexually explicit photographs, videos and offensive jokes about sex and gender.

DISPOSITION:

On the 30th of April 2004, Sergeant [redacted] retired from the Peel Regional Police Service. On May 10, 2004 the charge of Discreditable Conduct was withdrawn due to the fact that the Police Service no longer had jurisdiction.
