

- (b) retain and instruct counsel without delay and to be informed of that right; and,
 - (c) have the validity of detention determined by way of Habeas Corpus and to be released if the detention is not lawful.
6. When a member of this Service arrests a young offender, they shall provide the youth with the following instructions:
- (a) "You are charged with/arrested for (state charges and explain). Have the young person acknowledge that he/she is under arrest for the specific offence(s)/charge(s) being investigated";
 - (b) "It is my duty to tell you that you do not have to tell me anything about this charge unless you want to. Anything you do tell me may be used as evidence in proceedings (a trial) against you." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (c) "If you have spoken to any other police Officer or to anyone in authority or if any such person has spoken to you in connection with this case, I want it clearly understood that I do not want it to influence you in making a statement." Do you understand? What does that mean?";
 - (d) "You have the right to retain and instruct counsel without delay. It is my duty to tell you that you have the right to call and consult a lawyer. You can call any lawyer you want. You can speak to and get advice from a lawyer right now." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (e) "It is my duty to tell you that you have the right to call and consult your parent(s) or another adult relative, or if they are not available some other adult." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (f) "It is my duty to tell you that you also have the right to free advice from a legal aid lawyer." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (g) "If you are charged with an offence, you may apply to the Ontario Legal Aid plan for legal assistance." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (h) "1-800-265-0451 and 1-800-561-2561 are toll free numbers that will put you in contact with a legal aid duty counsel lawyer for free legal advice right now." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (i) "Do you want to call or consult a lawyer now?" We can get you a book with lawyer's names and phone numbers if you need one." If answer is yes, ask (and note) which lawyer he/she wants to call. If that lawyer is not available, ask him/her if there is any other lawyer he/she wants to call";
 - (j) "Do you want to call or consult your parent(s) or another adult relative or if they are not available, some other adult?" If answer is yes, ask (and note) who he/she wants to call";
 - (k) "If you call or consult with a lawyer, they are required to be here with you, unless you do not want to have them here with you." Do you understand? What does this mean?";
 - (l) "Do you want to have a lawyer here with you now?" If answer is yes, ask (and note) who";
