

- (n) kidnapping and abductions;
- (o) any shooting or any discharge of a firearm involving a police Officer, where there is no injury and which does **not** fall within the mandate of the Special Investigations Unit (S.I.U.);
- (p) sexual assaults that do not fall under the mandate of the Special Victims Unit;
- (q) industrial accidents, serious injury or when a death has occurred, and,
- (r) any other offence that requires the expertise of the Criminal Investigation Bureau.

## **G. Operation Support Services**

1. The O.I.C., Operation Support Services shall be responsible for the planning, organizing and coordinating of Operation Support Services activities and programs, in order to achieve annual goals and objectives. The responsibilities of Operation Support Services personnel are as follows:
  - (a) the Homicide and Missing Persons Bureau shall be responsible for the following investigations:
    - (i) homicides;
    - (ii) suspected homicides; and,
    - (iii) missing persons, (where suspicious or unusual circumstances are present, or the subject is missing for a period exceeding thirty (30) days, the bureau shall monitor the investigation); and,
  - (b) the Morality Bureau and its units shall be responsible for investigations, as outlined in P.R.P. Directive I-B-703 (F) or any other directives dealing with "Morality Related Offences";
  - (c) the Central Robbery Bureau shall be responsible for investigating:
    - (i) all financial institution robberies;
    - (ii) all robberies at a commercial/retail premises;
    - (iii) all taxi cab robberies;
    - (iv) all home invasion style robberies;
    - (v) all car jacking robberies; and,
    - (vi) any robbery that the Detective Sergeant, Central Robbery Bureau, in consultation with the Divisional Criminal Investigation Bureau, deems appropriate; and,
  - (d) the Special Victims Unit (formerly named the Child Abuse and Sexual Assault Bureau) shall be responsible for investigations, as outlined in P.R.P. Directive I-B-714 (F) or any other directives dealing with "Child Abuse Investigations" and P.R.P. Directive I-B-719
