(v) forgery, (excluding forged prescriptions); and,

Note: Refer to P.R.P. Directive <u>I-B-726 (F)</u> or any other directives dealing with "Fraud Investigations".

- (h) the Technological Crimes Unit shall be responsible for investigations, as outlined in P.R.P. Directive <u>I-B-411 (F)</u> or any other directives dealing with "Technological Crimes Unit";
- (i) the Commercial Auto Crime Bureau shall be responsible for investigations, as outlined in P.R.P. Directive <u>I-B-704 (F)</u> or any other directives dealing with "Motor Vehicle Theft Investigations"; and,
- (j) the Street Crime Unit, which is an enforcement and support unit to uniform divisions and shall be responsible for fulfilling the mandate as outlined in P.R.P. Directive <u>I-B-414 (F)</u> or any other directives dealing with "Street Crime Unit".

## H. Professional Standards

- 1. The O.I.C., Professional Standards shall oversee investigations relating to code of ethics, conduct and discipline. The responsibility of Professional Standards personnel are as follows:
  - (a) Investigative Support Bureau shall:
    - conduct the administrative investigation, on behalf of this Service, of all Occurrences resulting from the discharge of a P.R.P. Officer's firearm, where no injury occurs; and,
    - (ii) coordinate all P.R.P. investigations which fall within the mandate of the S.I.U., including:
      - shootings involving police Officers, where death or injury occurs; and,
      - deaths or injury which occur while a person is in custody; and,
  - (b) Internal Affairs Bureau shall be responsible for conducting all investigations which contain a criminal allegation or complaint against any member of this Service directed by the Chief of Police or designate.
