A. Purpose

- 1. The purpose of this directive is to provide members with guidelines:
 - (a) regarding the process through which Occurrence Reports are submitted, entered, checked, reviewed, work-flowed and/or assigned to appropriate area(s) of the service;
 - (b) defining the responsibilities of those members involved in the process; and,
 - (c) regarding the collection and submission of crime data to the Canadian Centre for Justice Statistics.

B. Policy

- 1. It is the policy of this service to ensure that:
 - (a) all Occurrence Reports are entered on the automated Records Management System in a timely fashion; and,
 - (b) accurate, valid Occurrence data is available to this service and the Canadian Centre for Justice Statistics, in compliance with the Revised Uniform Crime Reporting Survey.

C. Definitions

- 1. For the purposes of this directive, the following definitions shall apply:
 - (a) "automated Records Management System" means the in-house computer system, Niche and D.D.S. (Digital Dictation System);
