

- (a) ensure members are provided, upon hiring, information regarding victim/witness rights, and the role of P.R.P. in meeting those needs;
- (b) compile and maintain information that will serve to update and re-orient members of new, or, changes to programs or services; and,
- (c) liaise with the O.I.C., Staff Operations on a regular basis to ensure that:
 - (i) information regarding community service agencies identified as having concerns with victim and witness needs and rights are shared and disseminated to all areas of Peel Regional Police; and,
 - (ii) the changing role and responsibilities of P.R.P. in response to the needs and rights of victims and witnesses are assessed and acted upon in a timely, co-ordinated fashion.
