

**REPORT OF A DISCIPLINE OFFENCE TO
THE POLICE SERVICES BOARD**

SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

Count 1

During the course of her regular duties, Cst. investigated a motorist for a traffic violation. Investigation revealed the driver was a suspended driver and he registered a "warn" on a roadside screening device. As a result, the driver's vehicle was towed. Cst. deliberately failed to adhere to Peel Regional Police Directives and used a tow company that was not contracted to Peel Regional Police.

Count 2

Cst. approached her supervisors the day after the above incident to advise that she had contacted the contracted towing company; however, when they attended they refused to tow the vehicle. She then contacted another company to have the vehicle towed; a company which she is known to associate. Investigation revealed the contracted tow company was never in fact contacted. Cst. intentionally tried to deceive her supervisors to cover her actions.

Count 3

While performing her regular duties, Cst. was dispatched to a call regarding a disgruntled former employee who was in possession of a baseball bat and was threatening to kill other employees. Cst. attended the scene and spoke with the complainants who advised that threats had been made by the culprit. Cst. failed to properly investigate this matter and failed to submit a report, as per Peel Regional Police Directives.
