SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

Count #1

On October 13th, 2002 Constable was off duty when he was arrested and charged by Halton Regional Police with Impaired Operation of a Motor Vehicle and Refuse to Provide a Breath Sample. The officer plead guilty to both criminal code charges on November 14th, 2002 and received a substantial fine and a one year drivers licence suspension. The officer's actions brought discredit upon the reputation of the Peel Regional Police.

Count #2

On October 13th, 2002 Constable was negligent in the performance of his duties for failing to submit a controlled drug exhibit in accordance with Peel Regional Police policy and directives.

DISPOSITION:

- Count 1 Reduction in rank from 1st to 2nd class for a period of six (6) months, with a review by Divisional Superintendent at three (3) months.
- Count 2 One (1) eight (8) hour day to be worked at the discretion of Divisional Commander.
