**SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:**

On Monday March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2004 Constable \_\_\_\_\_, a member of the Peel Regional Police, was on duty and working as a Court Security Officer at the A. Grenville and William Davis Courthouse in the City of Brampton.

On this date in a Civil Motions Court, the presiding Justice had concerns how the involved parties would behave and requested the presence of a Court Security Officer for the duration of the hearing. Constable \_\_\_\_\_ was assigned this duty and attended the courtroom.

Prior to the conclusion of the court case Constable \_\_\_\_\_ left the court room and never returned. During Constable \_\_\_\_\_ absence the involved parties in the case became irate, causing safety concerns for the presiding Justice.

Constable \_\_\_\_\_ did not remain in the courtroom and she did not notify her supervisor or fellow Court Security Officers to arrange for a replacement. This resulted in no police presence in the courtroom for an extended period of time.

**DISPOSITION:**

Three (3) eight (8) hours to be worked at the discretion of her Divisional Commander.
