SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

On Friday, August 25th, 2006, Constable _____ is on duty and assigned to the Morality Bureau. Constable _____ was the officer-in-charge of a *Controlled Drug and Substance Act* (“CSDA”) telewarrant authorizing a search of a residence in Brampton.

The execution of the warrant was undertaken. The objective of the search was to locate a known and dangerous drug dealer within the residence.

The entry to the residence was undertaken as judicially authorized without knocking or prior notice of entry. On the morning in question, Constable _____ quickly realized that he had targeted the wrong address as there was no evidence of drugs or criminal activity within the residence. Further, the targeted drug dealer was not located within the residence.

The failure of Constable _____ to take sufficient steps to validate the address of the criminal target brought discredit to the reputation of the Peel Regional Police.

DISPOSITION:

Twenty-four (24) hours to be worked at the discretion of his Divisional Commander.
