

Count 4

During 2001, Constable [redacted] a member of the Peel Regional Police, while on duty, used Canadian Police Information Computer (CPIC) to query a number of individuals wanted on outstanding warrants. Constable [redacted] failed to make reasonable efforts to locate and arrest the persons named in the outstanding warrants contrary to Peel Regional Police directive. These facts became known to investigators after Constable [redacted] arrest on January 25, 2002.

Count 5

Constable [redacted], a member of the Peel Regional Police, returned from a trip overseas to Pearson International Airport on January 25, 2002. A search of his luggage by Canada Customs revealed approximately 219 grams of the controlled drug khat. He was arrested and subsequently charged by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police for Importing a Controlled Substance. On August 11, 2003 the Superior Court of Justice found Constable [redacted] guilty of a criminal offence.

DISPOSITION:

Counts 1, 2 & 5 Dismissal or resign within seven (7) day

Counts 3 & 4 Withdrawn
