SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:

Count 1

On December 20th, 2005, Constable was off-duty operating a Peel Regional Police mobile surveillance vehicle eastbound on Main Street East in Milton. Constable was involved in a single car departmental motor vehicle collision. Constable fled the scene prior to police arrival. Constable later admitted to having had consumed alcohol prior to the collision.

Count 2

On December 20th, 2005, Constable was off-duty operating Peel Regional Police mobile surveillance vehicle in Milton. He was involved in a single car departmental motor vehicle collision. Constable fled the scene prior to police arrival, leaving the vehicle insecure. Constable did not report the collision to a Peel Regional Police supervisor. Inside the vehicle was confidential police documents and police equipment that included a loaded Peel Regional Police firearm, contrary to Peel Regional Police Directive I-B-301(F).

DISPOSITION:

<u>Count 1</u> – Eighty eight (88) hours to be served at the discretion of his Divisional Commander. <u>Count 2</u> – Thirty two (32) hours to be served at the discretion of his Divisional Commander.
