

**REPORT OF A DISCIPLINE OFFENCE TO  
THE POLICE SERVICES BOARD**

**SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:**

In July of 2004, Constable [redacted] a member of the Peel Regional Police, while off duty, began attending the Northern Lights Public School located at 40 Bridgenorth Drive in Aurora. While in attendance at the school he would allow his dog to run loose on the property, despite being told he was not allowed to do so. This resulted in him being served with a Trespass to Property notice. Constable [redacted] during conversation with the school Caretakers, Animal Control Officer and the Town of Aurora's By-law Services co-ordinator, advised that he was a police officer.

Further, on November 17, 2004, Constable [redacted] while off duty, became involved in a dispute with a neighbour and again identified himself as a police officer. These disputes resulted in York Regional Police being contacted to intervene.

Constable [redacted] conduct brought discredit upon the reputation of the Peel Regional Police.

**DISPOSITION:**

Two (2) eight (8) hour days to be worked at the discretion of his Divisional Commander  
To attend a one (1) day course – "Dealing With Conflict"
