**REPORT OF A DISCIPLINE OFFENCE TO

**SUMMARY OF OFFENCE:**

On Sunday July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2005 Constable ... , a member of the Peel Regional Police, was "off duty" and in attendance at the Italian Cultural Centre located at #8 Automatic Drive, Brampton. At this time two male parties began firing gunshots into the air while standing in the parking lot.

Constable ... aware of the shooting incident, followed the suspect vehicle. Police 911 emergency was called and details of the incident were provided. Constable ... spoke directly with the 911 operator. He failed to identify himself and provided a false name.

Responding police officers conducted a high risk take down of the involved vehicle and occupants and arrested two suspects in possession of loaded hand guns. Some four hours later Constable ... attended 21 Division to inform the investigators of his knowledge of the incident. He provided a witness statement and failed to disclose the call to 911.

Constable Poyser was deceptive and negligent in failing to perform his duties as a police officer.

**DISPOSITION:**

Three (3) eight (8) hour days to be worked at the discretion of his Divisional Commander.
